To remove any confusion over which Saturday players are eligible to compete in the ASFA the following list has been compiled to assist in clarifying this matter for the 2005 season:

Rules relating to the playing of Saturday players:

1. Any player who has played for any of the above 38 teams will not be eligible to play for an ASFA team within 9 days of that game.
2. Any player who has been cautioned or sent off from the bench from any of the above 36 teams will not be eligible to play for an ASFA team within 9 days of that game.
3. Any player who was on the match-card but did NOT take the field from any of the above 36 teams may play for an ASFA team without the 9 day stand-down (subject to the conditions outlined in #2).
4. All Saturday players must submit all relevant details with the Registrations Officer prior to taking part in any match under the control of the ASFA.
5. All Saturday players taking part in any game under the control of the ASFA must be shown as a 'guest' player by indicating so on the match-card.
6. An ASFA team who is found to have breached any Rule and/or Regulation (including any points mentioned above) regarding the playing of a Saturday player will be penalised according to the Laws of the ASFA. Penalties will be imposed by the Executive Committee as it sees fit on a case-by-case basis.
7. The above rules are not applicable to NFSL reserve Leagues.
